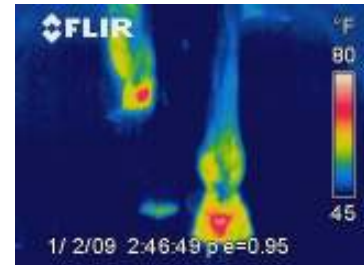

Gait Evaluations on the Treadmill with Ralph Casey, President. By using the treadmill, filming and playback in slow motion all aspects of Barefoot, Shod, Short Shoeing, etc can be observed by the owner. Always educational.

Infrared Thermal Imaging (Thermography) Imaging of hooves and whole body while on treadmill, and off, will help evaluate the conformation, barefoot, shod and shoes, lameness, in Dentistry, EFT, Nutrition, Saddle Fit and all demos.



Dentistry with Dawn Mannira, EqDT of Florida. Proper dental evaluation for floating and balancing to provide Grind, Slide and Jaw Alignment. Problem areas can be an offset bite causing sharp points, mouth ulcers and chewing problems leading to poor nutrition and food absorption. Most horses that fight the bit have locked up jaws. Power tools are used to benefit the horse and improve the overall dental. Appointments can be made, \$85.00 per horse.
